The Requirement

- The federal Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) revised their Hazard Communication standard in 2012 to improve employee recognition and understanding of chemical hazards in the workplace.
- New classification, labeling and safety data sheet formats are being implemented by chemical manufacturers in a process that will be complete by 2016.
- In response to these changes, the University of Alabama at Birmingham Department of Occupational Health and Safety and UAB Medicine is providing an update to the HazCom training to comply with the new requirements.
- As part of the University of Alabama at Birmingham Hazard Communication program, UAB Medicine and The Joint Commission requirements, employees in all healthcare areas, laboratory areas, and other departments where exposure to hazardous chemicals is anticipated are being assigned the Hazard Communication course.
